

Port Huron Yacht Club – Membership

Port Huron Yacht Club encourages sailboat racing as well as land based/social activities.

We hope that new members would be interested in sailboat racing or crewing for another member of our club. We are a working club where the members care for the facilities, maintain them as well as provide all of the functions of the organization.

Active Membership is held by an individual and is for personal use of the individual and the dependant family of that individual. Prospective members are sponsored or recommended by current active club members.

An Active Member of Port Huron Yacht Club can ask that a prospective members' name be placed on the waiting list to become a member. Active members are accepted once each year when openings become available.

Applications are accepted by the Membership Chairperson throughout the year with a non-refundable \$25.00 deposit which secures a future member applicants name on the waiting list. This deposit is applied toward their membership dues when an opening is available during the same calendar year. This deposit is good for one year on the waiting list. If no openings become available, a deposit would need to be paid again to remain on the list for another year.

When openings occur

A prospective member is invited to attend the annual Membership Meeting where they will be introduced to the club policies. Active memberships shall include a member's spouse, if married and their dependant children less than 18 years of age.

At this time – 2011

The Initiation Fee for a new membership is \$500.00.

Membership for one year is \$400.00 for those who live within a 35 miles radius of Port Huron Yacht Club. And \$500.00 for those who live outside of the 35 mile radius.

Other memberships

Junior memberships are for an active boating enthusiast who is a full time students under the age of 18 years. Fees are \$25.00 with sponsored application to the Membership Chairperson and 1% of the current Active membership Initiation Fee and dues when elected as a Junior Member.

Student memberships are for an active boating enthusiast who is a full time students and is over the age of 18 years. Fees are \$25.00 with sponsored application to the Membership Chairperson and 10% of the current Active membership Initiation Fee and dues when elected as a Student Member.

Additional types of membership are available to long time Active Members who qualify and are explained in the Membership handbook.

Mooring and Winter Storage – at Port Huron Yacht Club

Our wells are assigned to Active Members based on a point system. To qualify for a well an Active Member must submit an application which details their Club Service Points as well as other items listed on the application. The fee structure for the wells is a dues equity table which reduces the cost of the well and storage a %, each year for 10 years of membership to the basic fee and is determined on the size of the sailboat. Haul out and launch is paid under a different fee structure.
