

# **Kettle Point Race**

## **Saturday June 7, 2003**

### **Sailing Instructions**

The 2003 PHYC – SYC Race Program shall govern except as modified by these instructions.

### **Start**

Start between “F” mark and the Race Committee boat at the port end.

The following starting sequence will replace RRS rule 26 starting system.

Starting signals will be made at five minute intervals. Each signal will be removed one minute before the next is raised. Warning: yellow flag, one sound. Preparatory: blue flag, one sound. Start: red flag, one sound. Times shall be taken from visual signals; absence of a sound signal shall be disregarded.

### **Course and Marks**

#### **Kettle Point Course (K.P.)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> leg - 3.6 nautical miles; 342T to the red #12 channel buoy, rounded to starboard.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> leg - 18.1 nautical miles; 060T to Kettle Point buoy V4, coordinates 43 14.70min, 82 03.40 min., rounded to starboard.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> leg - 20.7 nautical miles; 230T to “X” mark, rounded to starboard.
- 4<sup>th</sup> leg - 0.5 nautical miles; 270T to finish line.

Total - 42.9 nautical miles; distance and course bearings are approximate only.

#### **Blue Point Course (B.P.)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> leg - 3.6 nautical miles; 342T to the red #12 channel buoy, rounded to starboard.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> leg - 10.2 nautical miles; 090T to Blue Point mark coordinates 43 05.25min, 82 10.77 min, rounded to starboard.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> leg - 10.5 nautical miles; 242T to “X” mark, rounded to starboard.
- 4<sup>th</sup> leg - 0.5 nautical miles; 270T to finish line.

Total - 24.8 nautical miles; distance and course bearings are approximate only.

#### **“D” Course**

- 1<sup>st</sup> leg - 3.6 nautical miles; 342T to the red #12 channel buoy, rounded to starboard.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> leg - 4.25 nautical miles; 136T to “D” mark, rounded to starboard.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> leg - 2.5 nautical miles; 300T to “H” mark, rounded to starboard.
- 4<sup>th</sup> leg - .96 nautical miles; 053T to “A” mark, rounded to starboard.
- 5<sup>th</sup> leg - 1.25 nautical miles; 165T to “CC” mark, rounded to starboard.
- 6<sup>th</sup> leg - 2.92 nautical miles; 211T to “X” mark, rounded to starboard.
- 7<sup>th</sup> leg - 0.5 nautical miles; 270T to finish line.

Total - 16 nautical miles; distance and course bearings are approximate only.

## **Blue Point Mark Description**

Six foot inflatable orange pyramid mark.

## **Finish**

Finish line is between SYC race committee building at the port end, near SYC harbor entrance, and red #2 channel buoy at the starboard end.

## **Late Finishes**

Boats finishing after 2000 hours shall take their own finish times and report them to the Race Committee. Illuminate sail at night.

## **Time Limit**

There shall be no time limit.

## **Course length**

The designated course length is shown below. Yachts shall sail the course designated for their class. Flag "S", when displayed indicates a shortened course. Courses will not be shortened after the start.
