

SARNIA - LEXINGTON RACE

Saturday, August 2, 2003

Due to low water levels preventing many yachts from entering Lexington Harbor the RC has shortened the traditional course to finish at Lexington. **There will not be a Sunday return race.** Dockage will be limited at Lexington due to the Art Fair scheduled for this weekend. Rafting will be required for some boats.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (Revised)

The 2003 S.Y.C. - P.H.Y.C. Race Program shall govern except as modified by these instructions.

START

The starting line will be between "F" Mark, at the Port end, and the RC Flag on the Race Committee Boat at the Starboard end.

The following starting method will replace RRS rule 26. Each signal will be removed one minute before the next is raised. Warning: yellow flag, one sound. Preparatory: blue flag, one sound. Start: red flag, one sound. Times shall be taken from visual signals, absence of a sound signal shall be disregarded.

COURSE

338 T, approximately 15.0 nautical miles, to Lexington breakwater.

FINISH

The finish line will be between the RC Flag, on the south end of the breakwater at Lexington Harbor and the orange pyramid mark at the starboard end. All boats shall record their own Finish Time and log the boat ahead and the boat astern at the time of their finish.

TIME LIMITS

There shall be no time limits. Race Committee personnel may leave the Finish Line at 1600 hours. Yachts finishing after 1600 hours shall take their own time and report it to the Race Chairman.

RETIREMENT

Boats retiring from the race shall notify the Race Committee at the Finish Line on VHF channel 69

***OTHER:** Boats starting in this class shall register with the S.Y.C. - P.H.Y.C. Race Chairperson 72 hours prior to the race date. These yachts must be S.Y.C. or P.H.Y.C. members or be invited by the Race Chairperson. Boats racing as "OTHER" do not qualify for awards.

NOTE: Boats, which dock at the Lexington State Dock and fail to register with the Harbormaster's Office, may not be scored.
