Join us for a fun race around buoys! This race is open to all PHYC/SYC registered boats, but all boats are limited to Main & Jib (after all, it is hosted by the Cruising Class!) We will start at CC a little after noon, head to C and make a left turn. When we reach D, we'll go back to CC, and then in to X and finish the race. There will at least 4 class splits by ratings, more classes depending upon registrations. Flags will be awarded to the top three finishers in each class the evening after the race.

We won't keep the fun just on the water, so you don't have to race to join in. We will hold a dinner at PHYC after the race. Your choice of Lamb Chops or Chicken as an entree, red skin potatoes with parsley-butter, salad, roll & desert. If you pre-buy dinner tickets, you'll get \$1 off per meal.

We will also enjoy music from a live band with a PHYC connection in the evening. The Synergy Band will perform after dinner and awards. NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The race will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Cruising Class Rules for series races sail limitations and accommodations for 2004 will apply. Boats that do not comply with the "Live Aboard" accommodations may be assessed a rating penalty.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The race is open to all boats registered with the PHYC/SYC race program for 2004, or by special invitation of the Cruising Class Fleet Captain. All boats will be limited to main and jib sails only for the duration of the race.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to Steven Styles, 445 Hemlock Lane, Marysville, MI 48040, postmarked by May 30, 2004.
- 2.3 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: Hand delivery of the attached form with the required fee and late charge at PHYC on Friday, June 4, to the Race Late Registration Representative between 6:00-7:30 PM.

3. FEES

- 3.1 Required fees are as follows:

4. SCHEDULE

The scheduled time of the warning signal for the race is 12:45 PM.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available not later than May 15 at the PHYC Race Board and at www.phyc.org. Final Class Splits will be posted at the PHYC Race Board not later than 9:00 AM on June 6.

6. THE COURSES

The diagram below shows the course, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left. The approximate course length will be 12.75 Miles. If a short course is displayed, after rounding Marker H, head directly to Marker X, and then to the finish line.

7. SCORING

- 7.1 The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply.

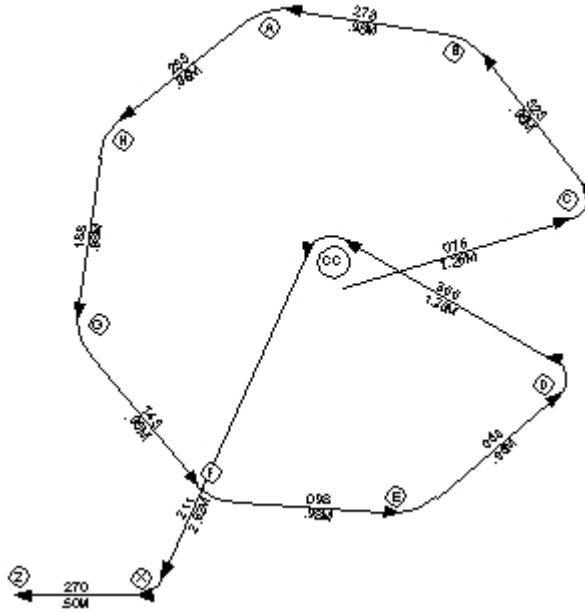
8. PRIZES
