NOTICE OF RACE**

1 RULES

- 1.1 The race will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Cruising Class Rules for series races sail limitations and accommodations for 2005 will apply. Boats that do not comply with the "Live Aboard" accommodations may be assessed a rating penalty.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The race is open to all LHYA associated club boats, or by special invitation of the Cruising Class Fleet Captain. All boats will be limited to main and jib sails only for the duration of the race.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to Steven Styles, 445 Hemlock Lane, Marysville, MI 48040, postmarked by US Postal Service by May 28, 2005, or hand delivered to PHYC in the Race Commodore's mailbox upstairs.
- 2.3 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: Hand delivery of the attached form with the required fee and late charge at PHYC on Thursday, June 1, to the Race Late Registration Representative between 6:00-7:30 PM.

3 FEES

- 3.1 Required fees are as follows:

\$10.00 US	Registration Fee
\$25.00 US (If paid after May 30)	Late Fee & Registration Fee

4 SCHEDULE

The scheduled time of the warning signal for the race is 12:55 PM.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be provided in the registration package that can be picked up at PHYC on Friday, June 2, between 6:00 PM and 7:30 PM, or on Saturday, June 3, between 10:00 and 11:00 AM. Final Class Splits will be posted at the PHYC Race Board not later than 6:00 PM on June 2nd.

6 THE COURSES

The diagram below shows the course, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left. The approximate course length will be 12.75 Miles. If a short course is displayed, after rounding Marker H, head directly to Marker X, and then to the finish line.

7 SCORING

The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply.

8 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: Flags 1st – 3rd for each class. Number of classes depends on registration.
