NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The series races will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US Sailing) national authority will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The races are open to all sail yachts who have properly registered by 0800 the day of the race.
- 3.2 Yachts must register for each race day individually.

4 FEES

- 4.1 There will be a \$20 fee required at registration for the LHOOD due at the skipper's meeting.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 The LHOOD (One Design & IRC) will be races on Friday August 29th, 2008.
- 5.2 The Friendship Race will be on Saturday August 30th, 2008.
- 5.3 The Memorial Race will be on Sunday August 31st, 2008.
- 5.4 See individual SI for warning signal times.
- 5.5 Skipper's meetings will be held the morning of each race.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1 The sailing instructions will be available by August 27th, 2007 on the PHYC Web Site (www.phyc.org). Final SI will be handed out at registration and posted at the Notice Board.

7 CLASSES

- 7.1 Classes
 - 7.1.1 PHRF – Yachts shall race in accordance with the Lake Huron PHRF By-Laws and have a Lake Huron PHRF rating.
 - 7.1.2 Cruising Class – (Jam or ASM)Cruising type yachts that will be rated in accordance with the Lake Huron PHRF By-Laws, with special limitations on sails.
 - 7.1.3 One Deign Classes will be held per design.
 - 7.1.4 IRC, max crew limits will not be enforces. Endorsed rating required.
- 7.2 Minimum yachts to form a class are five (5).
- 7.3 Registered yachts can not change class after 0800 the day of the race.
- 7.4 Yachts without a Lake Huron PHRF rating will be assigned a temporary rating for the weekend by LH PHRF.

8 THE COURSES

- 8.1 LHOOD will be raced as Windward Leeward.
- 8.2 The Friendship Race will be a set buoy course.
- 8.3 The Memorial Race will be a point to point course.
- 8.4 See sailing instructions for course details.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply.

10 RESULTS

- 10.1 Results will be posted on the official notice boards as soon as possible following a race.

11 PRIZES

- 11.1 Flags will be given to the top three finishers in each class of each race day.
- 11.2 Yachts racing as part of the LHOOD will be awarded overall to the top three finishers in each class for all race days.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 12.1 Competitors participate in the races entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the races.

13 INSURANCE

- 13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
