**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1 RULES**

- 1.1 The series races will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US Sailing) national authority will apply.

**2 ADVERTISING**

- 2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

**3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 Eligible yachts shall be entered by completing registration with the organizing authority in accordance with the "Schedule of Events". Eligible yachts shall be members of Lake Huron Yachting Association, member yacht clubs of LHYA, or DRYA, or upon invitation of the Race Chairperson.
- 3.2 Yachts must register for each race day individually.

**4 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS**

- 4.1 Friendship Race sign-up closed 2000 on September 4<sup>th</sup>, 2009.
- 4.2 The Friendship Race will be on Saturday September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2009.
- 4.3 Ed Beebe Memorial Race sign-up closed 2000 on September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2009.
- 4.4 The Ed Beebe Memorial Race will be on Sunday September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2009.
- 4.5 See individual SI for warning signal times.
- 4.6 Slipper's meetings will be held the morning of each race.

**5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 5.1 The sailing instructions will be available by September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2009 on the PHYC Web Site ([www.phyc.org](http://www.phyc.org)). Final SI will be handed out at registration and posted at the Notice Board.

**6 CLASSES**

- 6.1 Classes
  - 6.1.1 PHRF – Yachts shall race in accordance with the Lake Huron PHRF By-Laws and have a Lake Huron PHRF rating.
  - 6.1.2 Cruising Class – (Jam or ASM)Cruising type yachts shall race in accordance with the Lake Huron PHRF By-Laws and have a Lake Huron PHRF rating, with special limitations on sails.
  - 6.1.3 One Deign Classes will be held per design.
- 6.2 Minimum yachts to form a class are six (6).
- 6.3 Registered yachts can not change class after 0700 the day of the race.
- 6.4 Yachts without a Lake Huron PHRF rating will be assigned a rating for the weekend by LH PHRF.

**7 THE COURSES**

- 7.1 The Friendship Race will be a set buoy course.
- 7.2 The Memorial Race will be a point to point course.
- 7.3 See sailing instructions for course details.

**8 PRIZES**

- 8.1 Flags will be given to the top three finishers in each class of each race day.
- 8.2 See SI's for additional awards.

**9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

- 9.1 Competitors participate in the races entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the races.

**10 INSURANCE**

- 10.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
